RULES: All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by contacting the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, by phone (919) 233-9767, by email at info@akc.org, or on their website at www.akc.org.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY: The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the club or any official thereof.

REFUNDS: No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

100% of entry fees will be refunded for any reason if a written (or email) request is received by the [TRIAL SECRETARY](#) on or before the trial closing. After closing, refunds less \$6.00 in fees/day will be given for bitches in season if written (or email) notification is received by the [TRIAL SECRETARY](#) prior to the start of the trial. Verification from a veterinarian may be required at the club's discretion.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not on official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement attached, cannot be accepted. Checks for entry fees will be deposited soon after the closing date. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry, and a processing fee will be added to all returned checks.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog correctly. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for [move-ups](#) as detailed on Page 3) after the trial closing.** Prepare your entry form carefully, and double-check your preliminary confirmation. If you have questions about which class to enter, contact the [Trial Secretary](#) before the closing date.

ENTRY FEES: \$18.00 first entry (incl \$3.50 AKC recording fee), and for additional entries, same dog/same day: \$16.00 second entry (incl \$3.00 AKC recording fee), and \$14.00 each add'l entry.

ONLINE ENTRIES: Go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Services home page at www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries per day designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 80 runs/day via online entries, 250 runs/day via paper entries. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

A NOTE ABOUT ENTRY FORMS: This premium contains TWO entry forms. "Entry Form A" is suitable for printing and filling out by hand; "Entry Form B" is a FILLABLE form, suitable for filling out online, then printing. Choose one, or enter online.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been enrolled with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY: If you provide an e-mail address on your entry form, it is assumed you can receive e-mail with attachments. A preliminary confirmation will be sent via email soon after your entry is received; please REVIEW IT CAREFULLY and notify Ellen (the trial secretary) of any necessary changes as soon as possible. Please

make sure your spam blocker is set to accept messages from RedTileServices@gmail.com. If an email address is provided, a final confirmation of entry and schedule of judging will be sent via email after the closing date. If an e-mail address is not provided, confirmation of entry will be sent by USPS after closing (no preliminary confirmations will be sent). If you have not received a confirmation and schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact Ellen.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials (available at www.akc.org).

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups as a result of titles earned after entries close must be submitted in writing or email so that Ellen (Trial Secretary) receives them by **6:00 PM MDT on Monday July 13**. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to (replying to your final CONFIRMATION EMAIL is an ideal way to complete a move-up). If you do not receive a prompt acknowledgement of your move-up request, please contact Ellen to make sure that it was received. No phone move ups accepted. Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups for Saturday and Sunday must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the last class on Friday and Saturday,

For allowed changes from Novice A to Novice B, refer to Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

Process: When filling out the entry form, note the section to indicate your dog's jump height card status. You **MUST** check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*.

The **Yellowstone Valley Kennel Club and the Trial Secretary** assume **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

CATALOG: Pre-order \$10 catalogs on the entry form. A very limited number will be available for purchase at the trial for \$15 (exact change or checks only).

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for all qualifying scores and for first through fourth place in each height division in each class. New title ribbons will be available. A dog toy (offered by the club; value \$2.00-5.00) will be awarded to each dog entered over the weekend of trials (one toy per dog per weekend). All awards must be claimed at the show.

All dogs earning their MACH or PACH titles at this trial will receive a trophy bar and rosette! If you are close to earning an award, please let the [TRIAL CHAIR](#) know so your agility friends are prepared to celebrate with you.

SITE INFORMATION: White Aspen Ranch, 481 S 56th St W, Billings, MT

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds (and at your motel)!

BUILDING HOURS: On Thursday, July 16, the building will open for exhibitor setups from 6:00 – 7:00 PM (the club will be setting up the ring in the arena prior to the building opening for exhibitors; please do not enter the building or hold space prior to 6:00 PM). On Friday, Saturday and Sunday, the building will be open at 7:00 AM.

All dogs must be **on leash** at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area.

Message from the Trial Chair

Thank you for entering the Yellowstone Valley Kennel Club's July Agility Trial. We look forward to seeing many old friends and to making some new ones. We want to share some information that will enhance the trialing experience.

Site: The trial is being held at an active horse training and boarding facility. There will be horses along with their owners, trainers and staff around the area all weekend. Please respect the space of the horse folks as we expect them to respect and share the weekend with us.

Dog & Handler Potties: Handlers: Please use the provided port-a-potties to avoid strain on the water and septic systems. You may potty your dog on any grassy area. Dogs must be on leash at all times and "gifts" from the dogs must not be left behind. The area directly across from the front entrance to the arena is ideal for dogs to take care of business. There will be pick-up bags posted inside the fence in this space.

Parking: Parking is on the southeast side of the arena in the large gravel lot. Parking in front of the arena is designated for those who are physically challenged. Parking on the south side of the barn is for YVKC members and the trial secretary. There will be no other parking around the arena building. If there are any questions about parking, please ask.

Camping: Contact Deb Weisgarber for RV camping: rlbritts@gmail.com

Crating: Crating space is limited inside the arena building. Please arrange crates as closely as possible to one another and fold mats to fit under crates. X-pens will be allowed only in the equivalent space to crate the same number of dogs. There may not be room for chairs within the space designated for crating, but there will be space for competitors to watch the events on one end of the arena. Electric outlets are not available. YVKC reserves the right to move and/or consolidate competitors as necessary to provide the best experience for all; please be courteous, follow the instructions here and in your confirmation letter, and use only the space necessary for your crates.

Lunch: Negotiations with our food vendor continue as we write this letter. Our latest information is that Pita Pit will be providing food for the weekend. They will be serving limited breakfast items (breakfast pitas, muffins, fruit, juice and coffee) from 0730 to 0930 each morning. Lunch will be a variety of pitas, chips, cookies, fruit, soft drinks and water. YVKC will order a set number of lunch pitas for each day and when they are gone, they are gone. Workers will be provided a lunch ticket for working at least 3 events per day. A set number of lunch items will be set aside for workers, with the remainder of the items available for purchase until supplies run out.

Animal Chiropractic: Dr. Pat Holl, a licensed chiropractor living in Billings will be offering appointments outside the arena in her tent which is specially designed and furnished to care for her special patients. She is certified in Animal Chiropractic by the American Veterinary Chiropractic Association and the International Veterinary Chiropractic Association. She is staff chiropractor at the Yellowstone Naturopathic Clinic in Billings.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
