SECTION 2: ENTERING THE TRIAL

Wherever the word "dog" is used in this premium, it includes both sexes. This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP prefix), an AKC Canine Partners listing (MA prefix) or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs entered should be physically sound. Not eligible are dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form.

Entry Fees and Information for Entering

First entry of each dog (includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee) \$20.00
 Second entry of same dog (includes a \$3.00 AKC recording fee) \$17.00
 Third and more entries of same dog (includes a \$3.00 AKC recording fee) \$15.00

If entering via USPS mailed entry, mail entry forms and fees to address on entry form. Make checks payable to **Yellowstone Valley Kennel Club (or YVKC)**. Phone, fax and express entries will NOT be accepted. Any entry which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.

Online Entries may be made via the AKC online entry system. Online entries are encouraged as USPS mail delivery is inconsistent and timing unreliable.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: Online entries 100; Paper entries 250. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hr period, club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

Refunds

100% of entry fees will be refunded for any reason if written (or email) request is received by the TRIAL SECRETARY on or before the closing day and time.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, COVID-19 State or County requirements, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

The club will refund all entry fees for **bitches in season** when notification is received by the TRIAL SECRETARY at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trials.

Jump Height Divisions

Please check the box on the entry form so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs to Be Measured List.

All dogs competing must have a valid AKC Jump Height Card OR reasonably entered at an appropriate height. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter the dog at an appropriate height. Failure to do so may result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" jump height division. If a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Representative is present and wishes to provide measurements; dogs without a valid Jump Height Card (including those entered in the 24" jump height division) may be measured during the trial.

If you are entering your dog in both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial weekend, a separate entry form is required for each.

Notice to Exhibitors

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <http://www.akc.org/rules/>.

Safety is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor who themselves or whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Yellowstone Valley Kennel Club, the Trial Secretary and Yellowstone Dog Sports and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage, injury or illness sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility. No children under 12 years of age will be allowed at this trial. The Yellowstone Valley Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. Exhibitors and companions may be removed for failure to follow the COVID-19 event safety plan. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Yellowstone Valley Kennel Club or any official thereof.

During trial hours, all dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. The indoor arena TURF is NOT a designated exercise or play area for dogs. There are inherent risks for dogs who are off leash at Yellowstone Dog Sports which include but are not limited to: highway and other vehicle traffic, operating tractors, coyotes and other wildlife including bears and moose, stray dogs, open ponds, irrigation ditches, holes, barbed wire and other agricultural or construction debris. Dog owners accept full responsibility for injuries sustained by the handler, their dog or any guests attending the event with an exhibitor.

Crating space inside the arena may not be available for all entered exhibitors. Crating spots may be assigned by the trial committee. YVKC members and workers receive priority. Exhibitors should be ready to crate in their RV, rented room or in their car for this event.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
